

## WPLR Wildcat Challenge Rules

To be considered as one of the participants on the Wildcat challenge, you must return:

- 1) Your completed registration form and
- 2) Your completed waiver to:

**WPLR LISTENERS** will be instructed that they can pick up entry forms at WPLR 440 Wheelers Farms Road Suite 302 Milford Conn., at other locations (tba) or WPLR.COM. To enter contestants should send a picture of themselves and letter with their names, address, date of birth and a daytime & nighttime phone number and in 25 words or less state why he or she should be chosen to participate in the **WPLR WILDCAT CHALLENGE** to WPLR 440 Wheelers Farms Road Suite 302 Milford Conn. 06460 . All entry forms must be postmarked no later than midnight, June 4, 2002. No exceptions will be made. Qualifying takes place Monday May 20<sup>th</sup> 2002 through Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup> 2002. Three challengers will be selected to compete against Noel Aube who holds the record for the most consecutive rides on the Wildcat Coaster at Lake Compounce Theme Park. The record is 2001trips. We have granted Mr. Aube an automatic berth. To break the record, it will be necessary to complete 2002 consecutive rides during regular Lake Compounce park operating hours. All finalists and alternates will be chosen on Sunday June 9th 2002 on or about 2:00 p.m. Each qualifier will receive a prize from WPLR. A total of 3 finalist and 3 alternates will be selected and will be allowed to participate in the WPLR Wildcat Challenge against Noel Aube. You must be 21 or older to qualify. Identification will be checked in the event qualifier becomes a finalist. In the event atleast 3 qualifiers for said event can not be found, we will take listeners willing to ride the Wild cat, and that meet medical, and other eligibility requirements. One entry per person.

1. All potential finalists and alternates must be able to attend a meeting on Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup> 2002 sometime between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00p.m. at WPLR, 440 Wheelers Farms Road Milford, CT for an "orientation" of rules and procedures, and to sign release form. Each finalist and alternate must be in good health and certify their good medical condition. Each finalist and alternate will be checked by a Registered Nurse for all (vitals). At that time, the three finalists will draw seat positions in the Wildcat. The drawing of numbers and entering of the Wildcat will not be delayed for any reason whatsoever. One of the three finalists or Noel Aube must ride in the Wildcat for a total of 2002 complete trips to be considered eligible to win the grand prize, the last person remaining in the Wildcat will win the grand prize of a 19 foot Sugar Sand Ski Boat with trailer, valued at over \$18,000.00 (eighteen thousand dollars). In the event there is more than one person remaining in the Wildcat the winner of the Sugar Sand Ski Boat will be determined by a random drawing. Second place prize is two (2) 2002 Season passes to Lake Compounce valued at \$239.80 and a \$100.00 dollar gift certificate to Bob's Stores. Third place prize is two (2) regular admission tickets to Lake Compounce valued at 57.90 and a \$100.00 dollar gift certificate to Bob's Stores. Fourth place prize includes two (2) regular admission tickets to Lake Compounce valued at \$57.00 and a \$100 dollar gift certificate to Bob's Stores. In the event one of the finalist or Noel Aube is not actually able to ride in the Wildcat at the start of the 2002 trip, an alternate will be randomly selected. All finalist including Noel Aube must complete 1001 (one thousand one) complete trips or 10 (ten) contest days on the Wildcat to be considered eligible to win any prize. On Monday June 17<sup>th</sup> 2002 sometime between 7:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., all "finalist", alternates and Noel Aude will first meet at Lake Compounce at the guest relations office. Then they will be taken to a location where they will enter the Wildcat in the seat position that was selected, and in the order selected. Finalists who are not present at the specified day and time will forfeit any claim to win, and alternate number 1 (previously selected in order) will be selected to participate in the **WPLR/WILDCAT CHALLENGE**. Contestants are subject to disqualification by paramedics, for health or safety reason. Once disqualified, finalist/alternate has no claim to any prize. Decisions of judges and medical professionals are final. All three runners-up will receive consolation prizes determined by **WPLR**. In addition,

the finalists will be monitored for the duration of the contest. Any negotiating or conspiring by contestants will result in immediate disqualification.

2. Initial seating position will be selected by random drawing (i.e. out of a hat). However, each time the finalists leave the Wildcat for their 9 – 10 minute break, they will rotate to the next seat in the Wildcat. No alterations can be made to any seat.

3. The following are guidelines with which all contestants must comply to remain eligible. Any failure to do so will result in the contestant being disqualified:

- F. No electronic devices will be permitted inside the Wildcat or outside the Wildcat.
- G. No indecent exposure will be permitted -- clothes and shoes are required at all time.
- H. Arrangements for food are the responsibility of each contestant as is the disposing of garbage.
- I. No food or other items whatsoever will be allowed in the Wildcat. WPLR reserves the right to remove or put in any item/items in coordination with Lake Compounce (to be known herein as location) management and already existing location rules.
- J. A 9 – 10 minute break per person will be allowed every hour (1) hour.
- K. Any contestant not back in the Wildcat within 9 – 10 minutes will be disqualified. No exceptions will be allowed. All contestants will take breaks at the same time. In the event a contestant decides not to take a break, one cannot be made up at a later time. All contestants are asked to bring change of fresh clothing, or make arrangements to have fresh clothing brought for certain break times subject to (location) management.
- L. The WPLR morning show/on air staff reserve the right to put anything in the car at any time. WPLR or Lake Compounce staff is responsible for roll call.
- M. Throughout the entire event, any contestant that steps outside the (location) is disqualified immediately.
- H. No smoking or consumption /possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal Substances will be permitted in the Wildcat or (location). The (location) will allow smoking in designated areas only. Everyone must use bathrooms for removal of bodily waste. No catheter/colostomy bags permitted. No Depends or other adult diaper will be allowed. No urinal will be present inside the Wildcat. (Whether in a container or not).
- I. No excessive use of profanity will be permitted by language or gestures.
- I. Participants are not allowed to use any bullhorns, or other devices which create noise or disrupt the public environment
- K. No after -hour locations visits will be permitted.
- L. In the event of an evacuation of the (location), participants will need to comply WPLR may want to address how such an occurrence would affect the duration of the contest.
- M. Participants may not hail customers in a loud and obvious manner, and may not use any visual aid that might expose the public to harm or might be deemed objectionable by (location) management and WPLR.
- M. No horseplay, running throwing any type debris, disorderly or disruptive conduct of any nature which includes use of skateboards, bicycles or roller blades on (location) property.
- O. Any act which could result in substantial risk of physical harm to persons or property
- P. Literature distribution without prior permission of (location) management and WPLR in not permitted.
- Q. The playing of radios or musical instruments, not part of an organization approved by (location) management and WPLR is not allowed.
- R. No carrying a weapon of any kind. Possession of any article defined as a weapon whether illegal or not, i.e.: gun, knife, etc.
- S. Any act defined by Federal, State, or Local statute or ordinance constituting a criminal act will

not be tolerated.

- T. All garbage must be disposed of in proper areas - leaving garbage in the Wildcat or in the (location) floor will not be tolerated.
- U. Any other conduct deemed inappropriate by (location) management and WPLR will not be tolerated, including but not limited to negative comments made by contestants regarding WPLR, (location), its employees, or other sponsors.
- V. In the event finalist/participant starts to REEK, contestant will be asked to attend to their personal sanitation, clothing changes, etc., and may be disqualified if participant becomes insufferable.
- W. Contestants must participate in the **WPLR WILDCAT CHALLENGE** by completing 1001 trips on the Wildcat or at least ten (10) complete contest days whichever comes first.

4. Prize is non transferable and not redeemable for cash. No substitution of the prize. Finalist and alternates must have valid and positive ID.

5. WPLR shall not have the responsibility for failure to claim any prize based upon mechanical or printing errors, or allegations of telephone difficulties.

6. WPLR retains the right to reject any entry form which it believes to be incomplete or illegible. Winner will be responsible for all applicable taxes, tag, title, and any other miscellaneous charges.

7. The winners must show proof of identification, including social security number, and sign an affidavit of eligibility and release.

8. By participating in this contest, contestants grant to 99.1 WPLR FM radio, and (all other sponsors), and other participants the right to publicize and/or broadcast a contestant's name, character, likeness, voices, and the fact that he/she has participated in or won the **WPLR WILDCAT CHALLENGE** without receiving additional compensation.

9. By participating in this contest and/or accepting any prize in this contest, the winner releases WPLR Radio, Cox Radio Inc., Lake Compounce, Cerino's Marines of Clinton for any and all additional liabilities associated with the contest and/or said prize.

10. Decisions of the WPLR judges and medical professionals are final.

11. WPLR reserves the right to end the contest at any time for any reason without notice. In the event contest is canceled WPLR will pick one of the remaining contestants at random. All decisions of the WPLR judges are final.

12. WPLR reserves the right to change the rules at anytime during the contest. **WPLR** also reserves the right to discontinue this contest at any time without prior notice. **WPLR** reserves the right to disqualify any contestant who fails to comply with **WPLR** rules. If more than one contestant is remaining in the Wildcat at the end of the 2002 trips on (tbd), 2002, **WPLR** reserves the right to end the contest and pick a winner at random.

13. If a medical Specialist/Professional/Doctor/Nurse should pull someone for medical reasons, that person will be disqualified.

14. Employees of WPLR radio, Cox Radio Inc., Lake Compounce, Cerino's Marines of Clinton and Bob's Stores are not eligible to play the contest or in any way be part of the enjoyment of any of the prizes.

## **GUIDELINES**

- You must be at least 21 years of age
- No purchase necessary
